

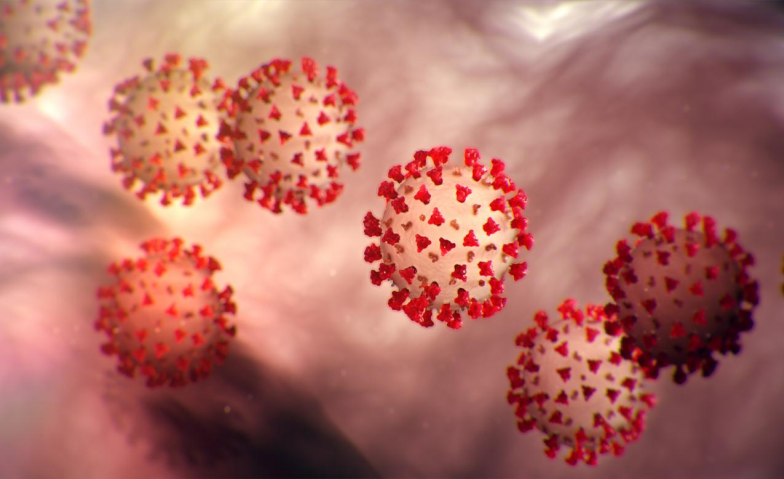

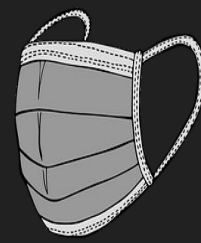

# WEAR YOUR MASK AT ALL TIMES



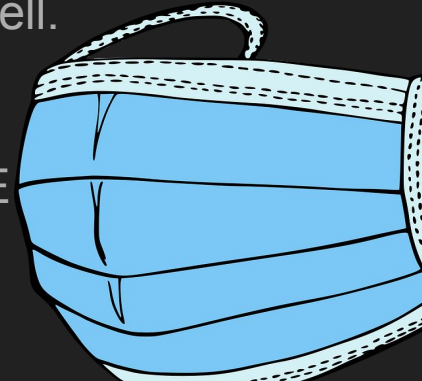
In the MTV community we always require you to wear your masks at all times ! We require masks to be over your mouth as well as nose.
